A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC WORK PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under the current
- 2 law, a contractor found to be in violation of the prevailing
- 3 wage law under chapter 104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 considered to have committed only one violation even though
- 5 other violative acts may be occurring or recurring
- 6 simultaneously on multiple public work projects performed by the
- 7 same contractor. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that a
- 8 violation of chapter 104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, arises with
- 9 each separate project in which the department of labor and
- 10 industrial relations finds that a contractor has failed to
- 11 comply with the law.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 104-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 14 "(d) A first, second, or third violation refers to each
- 15 [investigation involving one or more projects] project in which
- 16 the department finds that a contractor has failed to comply with
- 17 this chapter."

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun, before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
