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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that fire  
2 fighters, law enforcement officers, including county police,  
3 corrections officers, and department of land and natural  
4 resources' division of conservation and resources enforcement  
5 officers, and other emergency first-responders are fully  
6 prepared to respond to natural and manmade disasters, including  
7 acts of terrorism, by appropriating moneys to conduct a  
8 feasibility study for a Hawaii state public safety and emergency  
9 response training facility.

10           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1 or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for a consultant  
13 to conduct a feasibility study for a Hawaii state public safety  
14 and emergency response training facility. The study shall  
15 include such factors as an optimal site location, public safety,  
16 and plans. The governor may supplement funds for any cost  
17 element for this project by transferring any sums that may be




1 needed from the funds appropriated for other cost elements of  
2 this project.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
4 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
