
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 260, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) of section 2 to read as
4 follows:

5 "(a) There is established the Hawaii anti-trafficking task
6 force. The anti-trafficking task force shall be comprised of
7 the following:

8 (1) Individuals:

9 ~~[(1)]~~ (A) The attorney general, or the attorney general's
10 designees;

11 ~~[(2)]~~ (B) The directors of health, human services, and
12 labor, or their designees;

13 (C) The state public defender, or the state public
14 defender's designee;

16 designee;

17 ~~[(4)]~~ (E) The prosecuting attorney of each county, or the
18 prosecutor's designee;

- 4 (G) Hawaii contractees for services under the office
5 of refugee resettlement of the United States

8 States Conference of Catholic Bishops; and
- 9 (2) Representatives of:
- 10 (A) The immigration information office of the county
11 of Hawaii;
- 12 (B) The crime victim compensation commission;
- 13 (C) The office of the gender equity counselor of the
14 University of Hawaii;
- 15 (D) The Hawaii State Coalition Against Domestic
16 Violence;
- 17 ~~(+6)~~ (E) The Salvation Army;
- 18 ~~(+7) Sisters Offering Support;~~
- 19 ~~(+8)~~ (F) The Sex Abuse Treatment Center;
- 20 ~~(+9)~~ (G) GirlFest;
- 21 ~~(+10)~~ (H) Na Loio Immigrant Rights and Public Interest

5 [~~The Task Force~~] Task force members shall serve without
6 compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including
7 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties."

8 2. By amending subsections (d) and (e) of section 2 to
9 read as follows:

10 "(d) Not less than twenty days prior to the convening of
11 the regular sessions of 2007 and 2008, the task force shall
12 provide to the legislature a report on its activities[~~-~~];
13 provided that not less than twenty days prior to the convening
14 of the regular session of 2010, the task force shall provide the
15 legislature a final report of its activities.

16 (e) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30,
17 [~~2008-~~] 2010."

18 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$10,000 or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for travel
21 and clerical expenses of the Hawaii anti-trafficking task force.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008;
6 provided that section 1 shall take effect on June 30, 2008.
