# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending the definition of "pet animal" to read as  
3 follows:

4           "Pet animal" means a dog, cat, domesticated rabbit, guinea  
5 pig, domesticated pig, [~~or~~] caged [~~birds~~] bird (passeriformes,  
6 piciformes, and psittaciformes only), or horse so long as not  
7 bred for consumption."

8           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10          SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
