A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$55,300,775, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2008-2009, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the seventh senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Ball field and recreational facility
8 light system retrofit to comply with
9 Endangered Species Act.

2 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
3 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
4 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
5 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
6 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

7 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
8 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
9 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
10 follows:


- 11 (1) For items 1 and 18 the expending agency shall be the
- 12 county of Kauai;
- 13 (2) For item 2 the expending agency shall be the
- 14 department of defense;
- 15 (3) For item 3 the expending agency shall be the Hawaii
- 16 health systems corporation;
- 17 (4) For items 4, 5, 6, 20 and 21 the expending agency
- 18 shall be the department of education;
- 19 (5) For items 7, 8, 9, 15 and 19 the expending agency
- 20 shall be the department of land and natural resources;

2 agency shall be the department of transportation.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
