A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 twenty-fourth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Heeia elementary school

1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
5 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.


6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
8 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
9 follows:

- 10 (1) For items 1 through 12 the expending agency shall be
11 the department of education;
- 12 (2) For items 13 and 14 the expending agency shall be the
13 department of land and natural resources; and
- 14 (3) For items 15 and 16 the expending agency shall be the
15 department of transportation.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
