A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINETEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$90,597,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2008-2009, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the nineteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Barbers point elementary school

21 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 22 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at



1 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
2 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
3 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
5 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
6 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
7 provided that:

8 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 8 shall be
9 expended by the department of education; and

10 (2) The sums appropriated in items 9 and 10 shall be
11 expended by the department of transportation.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
