A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONDITIONAL RELEASE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 704-413, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: "\$704-413 Conditional release; application for modification or discharge; termination of conditional release
- 5 and commitment. (1) Any person [released] granted conditional
- 6 <u>release</u> pursuant to section 704-411 shall continue to receive
- 7 mental health or other treatment and care deemed appropriate by
- 8 the director of health until discharged from conditional
- 9 release. The person shall follow all prescribed treatments and
- 10 take all prescribed medications according to the instructions of
- 11 the person's treating mental health professional. If [any] a
- 12 mental health professional who is treating [any conditionally
- 13 released] a person granted conditional release believes either
- 14 the person is not complying with the requirements of this
- 15 section or there is other evidence that hospitalization is
- 16 appropriate, the mental health professional shall report the
- 17 matter to the probation officer of the [conditionally released]
- 18 person[-] granted conditional release. The probation officer



- 1 may order the [conditionally released] person granted
- 2 conditional release to be hospitalized for a period not to
- 3 exceed seventy-two hours if the probation officer has probable
- 4 cause to believe the person has violated the requirements of
- 5 this subsection. No person shall be hospitalized beyond the
- 6 seventy-two hour period, as computed pursuant to section 1-29,
- 7 unless a hearing has been held pursuant to subsection (3) [-];
- 8 provided that at or before the expiration of the seventy-two
- 9 hour period, a court may conduct a hearing to determine whether
- 10 the person would benefit from further hospitalization which may
- 11 render a revocation unnecessary. If satisfied, the court may
- 12 order further temporary hospitalization for a period not to
- 13 exceed ninety days, subject to extension as appropriate, but in
- 14 no event for a period longer than one year. At any time within
- 15 that period, the court may determine that a hearing pursuant to
- 16 subsection (3) should be conducted.
- 17 (2) Any person [released] granted conditional release
- 18 pursuant to section 704-411 may apply to the court ordering the
- 19 conditional release for discharge from, or modification of, the
- 20 order granting conditional release on the ground that the person
- 21 is no longer affected by a physical or mental disease, disorder,
- 22 or defect and may be discharged, or the order may be modified,

- 1 without danger to the person or to others. The application
- 2 shall be accompanied by a letter from or supporting affidavit of
- 3 a qualified physician or licensed psychologist. A copy of the
- 4 application and letter or affidavit shall be transmitted to the
- 5 prosecuting attorney of the circuit from which the order issued,
- 6 to the person's treating mental health professionals, and to
- 7 [any persons] the probation officer supervising the conditional
- 8 release, and the hearing on the application shall be held
- 9 following notice to such persons. If the [determination of the]
- 10 court [is adverse to] denies the application, the person shall
- 11 not be permitted to file [further] another application for
- 12 either discharge or modification of conditional release until
- 13 one year [has elapsed from] after the date of [any preceding
- 14 hearing on an application for modification of conditions of
- 15 release or for discharge.] the denial.
- 16 (3) If, at any time after the order pursuant to section
- 17 704-411 granting conditional release, the court determines,
- 18 after hearing evidence, that:
- 19 (a) The person is still affected by a physical or mental
- 20 disease, disorder, or defect, and the conditions of
- 21 release have not been fulfilled; or

- 1 (b) For the safety of the person or others, the person's
- conditional release should be revoked[7];
- 3 the court may forthwith modify the conditions of release or
- 4 order the person to be committed to the custody of the director
- 5 of health, subject to discharge or release [only] in accordance
- 6 with the procedure prescribed in section 704-412."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
