A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL FISHING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 189-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§189-3 [Monthly catch] Catch report[-]; mesh net fishing
- 4 reports; confidentiality of information. (a) Upon the demand
- 5 of the department, every commercial marine licensee shall
- 6 furnish to the department a report or reports with respect to
- 7 the marine life taken and any other information the department
- 8 may require for the purposes of this section.
- 9 (b) A commercial marine licensee shall immediately report
- 10 to the department every instance of fish caught by mesh net, not
- 11 including throw nets, that have remained in the mesh net for
- 12 forty-eight hours or more from the time of the catch. The
- 13 report shall include, but not be limited to, the reason for the
- 14 delay in removal of the fish from the net and a plan for the
- 15 immediate removal of the fish from the net.
- 16 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (c) Any information submitted to the department by
- 17 any person in compliance with any requirement under this section

- 1 shall be confidential and shall not be disclosed, except when
- 2 required under court order or pursuant to subpoena issued by the
- 3 department of the attorney general, or with the prior written
- 4 consent of the person submitting the information, or under
- 5 cooperative agreements with government agencies of the United
- 6 States for exchange and use of the information specifically to
- 7 manage marine life. The department, by rule, may establish
- 8 procedures necessary to preserve the confidentiality, except
- 9 that the department may release or make public any of the
- 10 information in the aggregate or summary form which does not
- 11 directly or indirectly disclose the identity of any person who
- 12 submits information."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
