A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SIXTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$116,616,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the sixth
6 senatorial district as follows:

 17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 19 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 21 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 22 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008. .
