A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$6,694,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2008-2009, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the ninth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Department of land and natural resources.

8 A. Waikiki seawall improvements, Oahu

9 Plans, design, and construction

10 for the resurfacing of the seawall

11 and installation of railings along

12 Waikiki's Gold Coast. This

13 project is deemed necessary to

14 qualify for federal aid financing

15 and/or reimbursement.

16 Plans/design \$200,000

17 Construction \$2,300,000

2 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
3 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
4 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
5 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
6 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

7 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
8 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
9 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
