A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$40,052,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2008-2009, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the second senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Mountain View elementary school, Hawaii

8 A. Americans with Disabilities Act

9 (ADA) transition accessibility

10 Total funding \$412,500

11 B. Covered walkway

12 Total funding \$220,000

13 2. Pahoa elementary school, Hawaii

14 Dining room facility

15 Plans and Design \$1,000,000

16 Construction \$6,700,000

17 Total funding \$7,700,000

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 12 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 13 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 14 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 15 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 17 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for
 18 the purposes of this Act; provided that:

19 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 5 shall be
 20 expended by the department of education;

21 (2) The sum appropriated in item 6 shall be expended by
 22 the University of Hawaii; and



1 (3) The sum appropriated in item 7 shall be expended by
2 the department of transportation.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
