17 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
18 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
19 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
20 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
21 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1, items 1-9, shall be
3 expended by the department of education for the purposes of this
4 Act. The sums appropriated for the capital improvement projects
5 set forth in section 1, item 10, shall be expended by the
6 department of transportation for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
