

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$\$, or so
 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, for
 staffing and operating expenses relating to the establishment of
 the office of the legislative analyst pursuant to section 21F-6,
 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the joint
8 legislative budget committee for the purposes of this Act.
9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
