A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 487-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§487-15~~ **Injunction.** The director of commerce and
4 consumer affairs or the office of consumer protection may bring
5 civil proceedings to enjoin any violation of section 487-13(a)
6 or any other unlawful act or practice affecting consumers,
7 trade, or commerce[-] in the State."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
