## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that conservation

organizations in the State are fighting to slow the invasion of

alien plants that are spreading from home and commercial

4 landscapes into native forests. The introduction of new plants

5 into Hawaii adds to the growing number of existing invasive

6 species that crowd out native plants and cover open fields.

7 Under section 150A-6.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the

8 department of agriculture is responsible for maintaining a list

 ${f 9}$  of restricted plants. The department is currently in the

10 process of developing its restricted plant list pursuant to this

11 section. Under section 152-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the

12 department of agriculture is responsible for designating certain

plant species as noxious weeds, and is required to publish and

14 make available to interest persons a list of designated noxious

15 weeds. The noxious weed list that is currently available was

16 last revised in 1992. Since then, many new plant species with

17 the potential for causing an infestation have been introduced

- 1 into Hawaii. Many plant wholesalers and retail outlets located
- 2 statewide sell these plants to customers for home and commercial
- 3 landscapes, thus potentially adding to the number of invasive
- 4 species in the State. The legislature further finds that an
- 5 increased effort is needed to control or eradicate the expanding
- 6 number of alien plant species and protect the State's native
- 7 plant population and agricultural economy.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 9 (1) Prohibit the sale of plants designated as noxious
- 10 weeds in Hawaii;
- 11 (2) Require the department of agriculture to annually
- review and, as necessary, update its list of noxious
- weeds; and
- 14 (3) Appropriate funds to allow the department of
- agriculture to review and update, on a regular
- 16 periodic basis, its lists of noxious weeds and
- 17 restricted plants, and its rules relating to
- 18 restricted plants, noxious weeds, and enforcement.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 150A-6.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 "§150A-6.1 Plant import. (a) The board shall maintain a
- 22 list of restricted plants that require a permit for entry into

- 1 the State[-], and shall annually review, and, as necessary,
- 2 update this list. Restricted plants shall not be imported into
- 3 the State without a permit issued pursuant to rules.
- 4 (b) The department shall designate, by rule, as restricted
- 5 plants, specific plants that spread or may be likely to spread
- 6 an infestation or infection of an insect, pest, or disease that
- 7 is detrimental or potentially harmful to agriculture,
- 8 horticulture, the environment, or animal or public health. In
- 9 addition, plant species designated by rule as noxious weeds are
- 10 designated as restricted plants.
- 11 (c) No person shall import, offer for sale, or sell within
- 12 the State any of the following plant species, or any portions
- 13 thereof:
- 14 (1) Salvinia molesta [<del>or</del>];
- 15 (2) Salvinia minima [and]; and
- 16 (3) Pistia stratiotes [plants or portion thereof within
- 17 the State]."
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 152-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 "§152-2 Rules. Subject to chapter 91, the department
- 21 [may] shall make rules to effectuate this chapter, including but
- 22 not limited to the following:

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1	(1)	Establishment of criteria and procedures for the
2		designation of plant species as noxious weeds for the
3		purposes of this chapter;
4	(2)	Establishment of procedures and conditions for the
5		initiation of cooperative agreements with landowners
6		and land occupiers for the purpose of eradicating or
7		controlling noxious weed infestations; and
8	(3)	Control or eradication of noxious weeds when deemed
9		economically feasible."
10	SECTION 4. Section 152-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
11	amended to read as follows:	
12	"§15	2-3 Prohibited acts. No person shall sell within the
13	State any noxious weed or any portions thereof. It shall be	
14	unlawful to introduce or to transport specific noxious weeds or	
15	their seeds or vegetative reproductive parts into any area	
16	designated pursuant to section 152-5 as free or reasonably free	
17	of those noxious weeds; provided that the introduction or	
18	transportation of those noxious weeds may be permitted for	
19	educational or research purposes when authorized by a permit	
20	issued by the department."	
21	SECT	ION 5. Section 152-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
22	amended to read as follows:	

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- 1 "§152-4 Designation of noxious weed. The department [may]
- 2 shall designate certain plant species as noxious weeds following
- 3 the criteria and procedures established under section 152-2(1).
- 4 The department shall publish and make available a list of
- 5 noxious weeds to interested persons [-] and shall annually review
- 6 and, as necessary, update this list."
- 7 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
- 10 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 11 year 2008-2009, for the department of agriculture to annually
- 12 review and, as necessary, update its lists of noxious weeds and
- 13 restricted plants, and amend its rules relating to restricted
- 14 plants imported into Hawaii, noxious weeds, and enforcement.
- 15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 16 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 20 provided that section 6 shall take effect on July 1, 2007.

## Report Title:

Invasive Species; Noxious Weeds

## Description:

Prohibits the sale of plants designated as noxious weeds. Requires the department of agriculture to review the noxious weed list annually and update the list, as necessary. Appropriates funds for the revision and review of the list of noxious weeds. (SD1)
