A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECYCLING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 342G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§342G- Recycling receptacles in state government
5 offices and buildings. Recycling receptacles for aluminum cans,
6 glass bottles, plastic containers, white and colored paper, and
7 newspaper, shall be installed and maintained in all state
8 government offices and buildings."

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
12 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2008-2009, for the purposes of implementing section 1 of
14 this Act.

15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
16 of accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.


