A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$1,245,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2007-2008, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the ninth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. W.P. Jarrett middle school

8 A. New cement foundation and floor
9 tiling for buildings A and B

10 Design \$100,000 for building A

11 Design \$100,000 for building B

12 Construction \$320,000 for building A

13 Construction \$320,000 for building B

14 Total funding \$840,000

15 2. Aliiolani school

16 A. Parking lot paving and drainage
17 improvements

17 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
18 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
19 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
20 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
21 of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
