
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The high school graduation ceremony is an
2 important and necessary event for most young adults. It is a
3 ceremony marking years of achievement in studies, not only for
4 the student, but for the whole family. However, participation
5 in the ceremony can be costly. Students are required to pay for
6 the use of the cap, gown, and other items, in order to
7 participate in the graduation ceremony. Additional costs are
8 also associated with other graduation-related activities,
9 including "Project Graduation" events. The costs associated
10 with graduation activities can make participating in some or all
11 of these activities difficult, if not impossible, for many
12 families struggling to meet expenses for the necessities in
13 life.

14 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for public
15 high school seniors to use toward graduation activities.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so



1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
2 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
3 year 2008-2009, to assist public high school seniors in covering
4 expenses related to graduation activities, including those
5 incurred by participation in graduation ceremonies or any other
6 graduation-related activities; provided that the amounts
7 provided to the public high schools shall be calculated based on
8 the total number of seniors estimated to be graduating that
9 school year on a per student basis.

10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
11 of education for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
