A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to create a
- 2 revolving fund for the collection of stipend repayments for
- 3 University of Hawaii students' breach of the Felix consent
- 4 decree recruitment and retention program agreement with the
- 5 department of education.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 8 and to read as follows:
- 9 "§302A- Felix stipend revolving fund. (a) There is
- 10 established the Felix stipend revolving fund into which shall be
- 11 deposited all moneys, received as repayment due to a break in
- 12 the contractual agreement between the student and the department
- 13 under its Felix consent decree recruitment and retention
- 14 program.
- 15 (b) The revolving fund shall be used by the department to
- 16 provide for the ongoing funding of stipends pursuant to
- 17 contractual agreements between students and the department under

- 1 its Felix consent decree recruitment and retention program, or
- 2 any successor programs."
- 3 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
