A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 132D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§132D-3 Permissible uses of consumer fireworks.** Consumer
4 fireworks may be set off, ignited, discharged, or otherwise
5 caused to explode within the State only:

6 (1) From 9:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New
7 Year's Day[+] and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on
8 Chinese New Year's Day[+ ~~and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00~~
9 ~~p.m. on the Fourth of July~~]; or

10 (2) From 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as allowed by permit
11 pursuant to section 132D-10 if the proposed cultural
12 use is to occur at any time other than during the
13 periods prescribed in paragraph (1);

14 provided that the purchase of not more than five thousand
15 individual consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
16 shall be allowed under each permit."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
