A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that an irreconcilable
2 conflict of interest exists when an ex officio member of a board
3 or commission, who is usually a department director, is also the
4 chair of that board or commission. A board or commission should
5 act independently of any department.

6 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit an ex officio member
7 of a board or commission from serving as chair of that board or
8 commission.

9 SECTION 2. Section 26-35, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

11 "(a) Whenever any board or commission is established or
12 placed within or transferred to a principal department for
13 administrative purposes or subject to the administrative control
14 or supervision of the head of the department, the following
15 provisions shall apply except as otherwise specifically provided
16 by this chapter:



- 1 (1) The head of the department shall represent the board
2 or commission in communications with the governor and
3 with the legislature[-];
4 (2) The financial requirements from state funds of the
5 board or commission shall be submitted through the
6 head of the department and included in the budget for
7 the department[-];
8 (3) All rules [~~and regulations~~] adopted by the board or
9 commission shall be subject to the approval of the
10 governor[-];
11 (4) The employment, appointment, promotion, transfer,
12 demotion, discharge, and job descriptions of all
13 officers and employees of or under the jurisdiction of
14 the board or commission shall be determined by the
15 board or commission subject to the approval of the
16 head of the department and to applicable personnel
17 laws[-];
18 (5) All purchases of supplies, equipment, or furniture by
19 the board or commission shall be subject to the
20 approval of the head of the department[-];
21 (6) The head of the department shall have the power to
22 allocate the space or spaces available to the



1 department and which are to be occupied by the board
2 or commission[+];

3 (7) Any quasi-judicial functions of the board or
4 commission shall not be subject to the approval,
5 review, or control of the head of the department[-];

6 (8) Except as set forth hereinabove, the head of the
7 department shall not have the power to supervise or
8 control the board or commission in the exercise of its
9 functions, duties, and powers[-]; and

10 (9) An ex officio member of a board or commission shall
11 not serve as head of that board or commission."

12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
