
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE COLLEGE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Hawaiian language college at the University
2 of Hawaii has had several important achievements since the
3 legislative mandate for its establishment ten years ago. The
4 legislature finds that funding for its programs and faculty have
5 not been consistent with the achievements and activities of the
6 college.

7 The purpose of this Act is to fund the Hawaiian language
8 college at the University of Hawaii so it can continue its
9 contributions, leadership, and achievements in the area of
10 indigenous language teaching and revitalization.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$608,000, or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, for the
14 Hawaiian language college at the University of Hawaii.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
16 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
