## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

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#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the establishment of a revolving fund for the department of education's office of Hawaii child nutrition program is necessary to account for the receipts from the administrative fees charged to the recipient agencies for the distribution of federal commodity foods.

The legislature further finds that the United States

Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service, Western Region Office, monitors and approves the administrative fees charged to the recipient agencies. However, federal legislation does not allow the department of education to expend federal moneys for the operations of state contracted warehouses.

The purpose of this Act is to create a revolving fund for the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to support the administration and operation of the department of education food distribution program.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§302A- Food distribution program revolving fund. (a)		
5	There is established the food distribution program revolving		
6	fund to be administered by the department.		
7	(b) The food distribution program revolving fund shall		
8	consist of:		
9	(1) Admini	strative fees collected by the department for	
10	admini	stering and operating the food distribution	
11	progra	ım;	
12	(2) All ir	nterest earned on the deposit or investment of	
13	moneys	in the food distribution program revolving	
14	fund;	and	
15	(3) Any ot	her moneys made available to the food	
16	distri	bution program revolving fund from other	
17	source	<u>:s.</u>	
18	(c) The re	evolving fund shall be used by the department for	
19	the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to support		
20	the administration and operation of the food distribution		
21	program.		

1	(d) The balance in the food distribution program revolving		
2	fund shall not exceed the sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof		
3	as may be necessary to pay for services rendered by the state		
4	contracted warehouses for the distribution of federal commodity		
5	foods to the recipient agencies. Any moneys remaining in the		
6	revolving fund in excess of \$2,000,000 at the end of each fiscal		
7	year shall lapse to the credit of the general fund.		
8	(e) The food distribution program revolving fund shall not		
9	be used for:		
10	(1) Consultant or personal services rendered;		
11	(2) Travel expenses that may include conference		
12	registration, per diem, or airfare costs; or		
13	(3) The purchase of furniture, equipment, computer		
14	hardware, or office supplies."		
15	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the food		
16	distribution program revolving fund of the State of Hawaii the		
17	sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for		
18	fiscal year 2007-2008, and the same sum, or so much thereof as		
19	may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, for the payment of		
20	services provided by state contracted warehouses for the		
21	distribution of federal commodity foods to recipient agencies		
22	under the department of education food distribution program.
