# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SCIENCE EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Act 160, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006,  
2 appropriated \$2,000,000 for purchasing science textbooks and  
3 teaching resources. Fifteen complex areas submitted requests  
4 totaling nearly \$6,000,000.

5           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for science  
6 textbooks and other teaching resources; provided that schools  
7 within a complex receiving funds have a K-12 articulated science  
8 curriculum.

9           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,000,000, or so  
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to  
12 purchase science textbooks and other teaching resources;  
13 provided that schools within a complex receiving funds have a  
14 K-12 articulated science curriculum.

15           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
16 education for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
