## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

## REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A FINANCIAL AND MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES MEDICAID-SPONSORED PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, in 1965, the United States Congress established 1 Medicaid as a jointly funded state and federal program that 2 3 provides medical assistance to low-income individuals who 4 qualify under Title XIX of the Social Security Act; and 5 6 WHEREAS, within a general statutory framework, each state 7 creates and administers its own Medicaid program; and 8 9 WHEREAS, in the State of Hawaii, the Med-QUEST Division of the Department of Human Services administers the Medicaid 10 11 program; and 12 WHEREAS, the Med-QUEST Division oversees a number of 13 programs that provide coverage for certain medical, mental 14 health, and dental services for gualified children and adults 15 including Medicaid Fee-For-Service, Hawaii QUEST, QUEST-Net, and 16 QUEST Adult Coverage Expansion; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the various Med-QUEST programs are financed 19 through the State and the Federal Centers for Medicare and 20 Medicaid Services: and 21 22 WHEREAS, in 2007, Med-QUEST programs enrolled over 200,000 23 Hawaii residents; and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, the most vulnerable in our communities can depend on Medicaid to provide essential and emergent medical 27 assistance, and the program's continued financial viability is 28 vital to ensure continued access to needed services; and 29 30 WHEREAS, a financial and management audit of the Department 31 of Human Services Medicaid-sponsored programs would enhance 32



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public awareness of the programs' budgets and spending, thereby 1 increasing transparency and accountability; now, therefore, 2 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 4 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 6 requested to conduct a financial and management audit of 7 Department of Human Services Medicaid-sponsored programs to 8 identify any areas of concern regarding, but not limited to, fee 9 schedules, rates of federal reimbursement, financial shortfalls, 10 and program delivery and implementation; and 11 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Human Services is requested to cooperate with and assist the Auditor 14 in the performance of this audit; and 15 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to submit a report of any audit findings and recommendations, 18 including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later 19 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 20 of 2009; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 23 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to Governor, the Director 24 25 of Human Services, the Administrator of the Med-QUEST Division, and the Auditor. 26 27 28 29 OFFERED BY:

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
