SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

CALLING FOR A JOINT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE FOR THE PURPOSE
OF APPOINTING THE AUDITOR, THE DIRECTOR OF THE LEGISLATIVE
REFERENCE BUREAU, AND THE OMBUDSMAN.

1 WHEREAS, Article VII, section 10, of the Constitution of
2 the State of Hawaii, provides that the Legislature, by a
3 majority vote of each house in joint session, shall appoint an
4 Auditor who shall serve for a period of eight years; and

6 WHEREAS, section 23G-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, provides
7 that the Legislature, by a majority vote of each house in joint
8 session, shall appoint a Director for the Legislative Reference
9 Bureau who shall serve for a period of six years; and

11 WHEREAS, section 96-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, provides
12 that the Legislature, by a majority vote of each house in joint
13 session, shall appoint an Ombudsman who shall serve for a period
14 of six years; now, therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth
17 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the
18 House of Representatives concurring, that the two houses of the
19 Legislature assemble in joint session in the chambers of the
20 Senate on Thursday, May 1, 2008, at 12:00 p.m. for the purpose
21 of appointing Marion M. Higa as Auditor, Ken H. Takayama as
22 Director of the Legislative Reference Bureau, and Robin K.
23 Matsunaga as Ombudsman, whose terms shall commence on July 1,
