SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO PROCLAIM JUNE 8TH OF EVERY YEAR AS
WORLD OCEAN DAY.

1 WHEREAS, the concept of World Ocean Day was established in
2 1992 at the United Nations Earth Summit; and

4 WHEREAS, it is an opportunity for the world to celebrate
5 and recognize the significance of the world ocean to our lives;
6 and

8 WHEREAS, the world ocean is critical to maintaining our
9 planet's ecosystem and essential to human health and well-being;
10 and

12 WHEREAS, the world ocean encompasses seventy per cent of
13 the surface of our planet, yet less than one per cent of the
14 world ocean habitat is protected; and

16 WHEREAS, ocean environments around the world are
17 collapsing, primarily due to over-fishing, pollution, and
18 unsustainable coastal development; and

20 WHEREAS, Hawaii's isolation in the middle of the Pacific
21 Ocean and its distinction as being the farthest removed islands
22 from any other body of land in the world make it an appropriate
23 participant in World Ocean Day; and

25 WHEREAS, the ocean is an integral part of every facet of
26 the lives of the people of Hawaii; and

28 WHEREAS, Hawaii is the proud steward of the largest portion
29 of protected ocean in the world with coral reef ecosystems that
30 contain over five thousand known species of marine plants and
31 animals; and

 2 WHEREAS, World Ocean Day is an opportunity to educate the
 3 public, adults and children alike, about conserving and
 4 protecting our fragile marine environment; now, therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth
 7 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the
 8 House of Representatives concurring, that the Governor is
 9 requested to proclaim June 8th of every year as World Ocean Day;

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 13 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Hawaii's
 14 congressional delegation, and to the Mayor and the Chairperson
 15 of the Council of each county.
