SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE LEGACY LAND CONSERVATION COMMISSION
RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES THAT
THE LAND DESCRIBED AS THE NORTH SHORE HERITAGE PARK ON MAUI
HAS VALUE AS A RESOURCE TO THE STATE AND SHOULD BE ACQUIRED
BY THE STATE AS LEGACY LANDS.

1 WHEREAS, there is property on the North Shore of Maui
2 located between Sprecklesville and Paia which is hereinafter
3 described as the "North Shore Heritage Park"; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the North Shore Heritage Park consists of six
6 parcels of land which are described as follows:
7

- 8 (1) Approximately 43 acres described as TMK II 3-8-01,
9 parcel 72, stretching from Kelaakai Place in
10 Sprecklesville to the western boundary of H.P. Baldwin
11 Park Road in Paia, which includes natural sand dunes,
12 coastal beaches, and wetlands;
13
- 14 (2) Approximately 17 acres known as H.P. Baldwin Park
15 which is described as TMK II 2-5-05, Parcel 47 (4.6
16 acres) and parcel 46 (12.5 acres);

- 18 (3) Approximately 4.5 acres of coastal lands stretching
19 from the eastern border of H.P. Baldwin Park to the
20 Maui Youth and Cultural Center which is described as
21 TMK II 2-6-01, parcel 1 (3.517 acres) and parcel 4
22 (1.08 acres);

- 24 (4) Approximately 32 acres described as TMK II 2-5-05;
25 parcel 17;

- 27 (5) Approximately 5.7 acres known as Lime Kiln Beach which
28 is described as TMK II 2-5-05, parcel 14; and

- 30 (6) Approximately 26 acres known as Stable Road Beach
31 which is described as TMK II 3-8-01, parcel 3; and

1 WHEREAS, there is great concern that the lands making up
2 the North Shore Heritage Park are susceptible to development;
3 and
4

5 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State and its
6 residents to maintain the North Shore Heritage Park in an
7 undeveloped state which would provide for access to public
8 beaches and open spaces; and
9

10 WHEREAS, the North Shore Heritage Park has value as a
11 resource of the State and should be acquired by the State as
12 legacy lands; and

14 WHEREAS, the initial step required in order to have the
15 State acquire the North Shore Heritage Park as legacy lands is
16 to have the Legacy Land Conservation Commission recommend such
17 an acquisition to the Board of Land and Natural Resources; now,
18 therefore,
19

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth
21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008,
22 that the Legacy Land Conservation Commission is urged to
23 identify the North Shore Heritage Park as lands which have value
24 as a resource to the State; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legacy Land Conservation
27 Commission is urged to recommend to the Board of Land and
28 Natural Resources that the North Shore Heritage Park be acquired
29 by the State as legacy lands in order to preserve open spaces
30 and access to public beaches; and

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
33 Resolution be transmitted to the Legacy Land Conservation
34 Commission, the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and the
35 Department of Land and Natural Resources.
