Your Committees on Higher Education and Labor & Public
Employment, to which was referred H.B. No. 1013 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPERIENTIAL
LEARNING,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to broaden the education and
career choices of Hawaii's students by increasing the availability
of experiential learning opportunities. Specifically, this bill
appropriates funds for the University of Hawaii to:

- (1) Research and develop a statewide web-based database of
experiential learning opportunities; and
- (2) Perform a study to identify and determine barriers to
businesses and organizations that wish to volunteer to
provide experiential learning opportunities to students.

The Workforce Development Council and CTA Solutions testified
in support of this bill. The Department of Education and Hawaii
P-20 Initiative supported the intent of this measure.

Your Committees have amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing the appropriation amounts to \$1 to encourage
further discussion; and


- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
