Your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 1182 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PUNA DISTRICT POLICE STATION IN KEA'AU, HAWAI'I,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide a grant-in-aid to the County of Hawaii to ensure that police officers in the rapidly growing Puna District of the island of Hawaii have an adequate police station.

The Mayor and Police Department of the County of Hawaii testified in support of this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing the appropriation to \$1 to facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
