Your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs, to which
was referred H.B. No. 1405 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to support the efforts of the
Department of Public Safety (DPS) relating to controlled
substances. This bill expands the use of the Controlled Substance
Registration Revolving Fund to include the costs of:

- (1) Operating the Narcotics Enforcement Division's forensic
drug laboratory; and
- (2) Investigating violations relating to the registration
and control of controlled substances.

DPS testified in support of this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2015, to
facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.
