Sir:

Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 2141
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EDUCATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to reduce the incidence of
cervical cancer among Hawaii's female youth caused by the sexually
transmitted human papillomavirus. This bill appropriates
unspecified sums to establish a program to:

- (1) Develop and provide free educational information to
parents of female public school sixth graders on human
papillomavirus vaccines that prevent cervical cancer;
and
- (2) Make human papillomavirus immunizations available to
these students.

The Department of Health supported the intent of this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to January 1, 2050, to
encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2141, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 2141, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Education.
