Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 239 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING A MATCHING FUNDS APPROPRIATION TO
INCREASE STUDENT ON-CAMPUS AND NEARBY HOUSING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to alleviate the critical
shortage of student housing throughout the University of Hawaii
(UH) system by:

- (1) Authorizing the UH Board of Regents to enter into
agreements with private developers to develop new
student housing or convert existing housing into student
housing on or near UH campuses; and
- (2) Appropriating funds for such public-private agreements.


UH testified in support of this bill.
