Sir:

Your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs, to which  
was referred H.B. No. 2467 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to improve fire protection by  
directing that the State Fire Code will include road and sign  
standards, minimum private water supply reserves, fuel breaks, and  
green belts.

A concerned individual supported this bill. The Department  
of Land and Natural Resources supported the intent of this  
measure. The State Fire Council provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Clarifying that the State Fire Code will provide  
requirements for any property on which the county does  
not have jurisdiction over road and sign standards,  
minimum private water supply reserves, fuel breaks, and  
green belts to improve fire protection; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive changes for clarity,  
consistency, and style.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2467, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 2467, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Water, Land, Ocean Resources & Hawaiian Affairs.


