Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 2529
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FOOD SAFETY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to improve food safety by
requiring the Department of Health to establish procedures dealing
with tainted foods processed for consumption by humans and pet
animals and appropriating funds for the purpose.

Animal Rights Hawaii testified in support of this bill. The
Department of Health and the Grocery Manufacturers Association
opposed this measure.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to January 1, 2050; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style,
clarity, and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
2529, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 2529, H.D. 1, and
be referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
