Your Committee on Tourism & Culture, to which was referred  
H.B. No. 3325 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIFORM LAND SALES  
PRACTICES ACT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to streamline the regulation of  
time share plans by exempting registered time share plans from the  
provisions of the Uniform Land Sales Practices Act.

The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Marriott  
International, Inc., ARDA-Hawaii, and Wyndham Worldwide supported  
this bill.

Upon further consideration, your Committee has amended this  
measure by changing its effective date to July 1, 2025, to  
encourage further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Tourism & Culture that is attached to this report,  
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.  
No. 3325, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second  
Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 3325, H.D. 1, and  
be referred to the Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
