Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 456  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MEDICAID,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide access to emergency  
contraceptives for women who are Medicaid recipients, who may not  
be able to otherwise obtain emergency contraceptives, by providing  
funding and requiring the Department of Human Services to directly  
reimburse sales of over-the-counter Plan B emergency contraception  
to women who are recipients of Medicaid without incurring out-of-  
pocket expenses.

The Hawaii Medical Association and Healthy Mothers, Healthy  
Babies Coalition of Hawaii testified in support of this bill. The  
Department of Human Services supported the intent of this measure.  
Hawaii Right to Life and a concerned individual opposed this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:


- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2020, to  
encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style,  
clarity, and consistency.
