entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HOUSING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to protect Del Monte employees
and retirees from losing their homes by:

- (1) Directing the Department of Accounting and General
Services (DAGS) Land Survey Division to determine the
boundaries of the Kunia Plantation Camp; and
- (2) Appropriating funds for the purchase of the Kunia
Plantation Camp from Campbell Estate to allow the
present occupants to purchase their homes.

The ILWU Local 142 testified in support of this bill. DAGS
opposed this measure.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:


- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2020, to
encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.
