H.C.R. No. 276 entitled:

OF HAWAII SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK DEDICATE ITS SCHOOL IN HONOR  
OF MYRON "PINKY" THOMPSON, BY CHANGING ITS NAME TO "THE MYRON  
THOMPSON SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK", "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to dedicate the  
University of Hawaii (UH) School of Social Work in honor of Myron  
"Pinky" Thompson by changing the name of the school to the "Myron  
Thompson School of Social Work."

The two senators of Hawaii's congressional delegation,  
Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs, Kamehameha Schools, National  
Association of Social Workers, Hawaii Chapter, Papa Ola Lokahi,  
Partners in Development Foundation, and several concerned  
individuals testified in support of this resolution. The UH at  
Manoa School of Social Work offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this concurrent resolution by:

- (1) Requesting the UH Board of Regents to consider making an  
exception to its rule that a UH building or school can  
be named only if a minimum \$25,000,000 donation is made,  
in light of Myron "Pinky" Thompson's momentous

- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.


