Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 302 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO ADOPT A "COMPLETE STREETS" POLICY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to encourage
alternative modes of transportation, particularly bicycling and
walking, through comprehensive planning by urging the Department
of Transportation (DOT) to adopt a "Complete Streets" policy.

The Hawaii Bicycling League, Maui Bicycle Alliance, and
several concerned individuals testified in support of this
measure. DOT supported the intent of this measure.

Decreased traffic congestion, improved environmental
conditions, and increased health and wellness are some of the
benefits a community may experience by adopting alternative modes
of transportation, such as bicycling and walking. However, to
accommodate all modes of transportation and access for all users,
including motorists, bicyclists, pedestrians, and transit riders,
adequate planning is necessary during all phases of roadway
development. "Complete Streets" policies are intended to look at
all transportation options and plan for their implementation
accordingly so as to avoid costly infrastructure retrofitting in
the future.
