Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 357 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF
HAWAII COLLEGE OF TROPICAL AGRICULTURE AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO
STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A MULTIPURPOSE, MULTI-
USER AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS PROCESSING FACILITY OR
FACILITIES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to support the
production of value-added products that make use of locally-grown
agricultural products by requesting the University of Hawaii
College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources to study the
feasibility of constructing a multipurpose, multi-user processing
facility in which these products can be processed, packaged, and
assembled.

A concerned individual testified in support of the intent of
this measure.

Your Committee has amended this concurrent resolution by:

- (1) Inserting provisions relating to the availability of
land in the Ewa, central Oahu area on which such a
facility could be built, as Campbell Estate has offered
to donate to the Hawaii Agriculture Research Center
approximately 119 acres of land together with

improvements, including agricultural worker housing and existing facilities for agricultural offices and agribusinesses;

- (2) Narrowing the scope of the study to the feasibility of constructing the facility on this land, and accordingly, changing its title to read, "REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COLLEGE OF TROPICAL AGRICULTURE AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A MULTIPURPOSE, MULTI-USER PROCESSING FACILITY ON THE LAND IN THE EWA, CENTRAL OAHU AREA BEING OFFERED TO THE HAWAII AGRICULTURE RESEARCH CENTER, FOR THE PRODUCTION OF VALUE-ADDED PRODUCTS THAT MAKE USE OF LOCALLY-GROWN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS"; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 357, as amended herein, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto as H.C.R. No. 357, H.D. 1.
