Upon review of the statements submitted by the nominees, your Committee finds that the aforementioned nominees will work with compassion and commitment to assist in administering the government functions related to elder affairs services. Your Committee further finds that the nominees have been appointed based upon their credentials, integrity, and a desire to make Hawaii better through their participation on the Policy Advisory Board for Elder Affairs to which they have been nominated.



Your Committee received testimony supporting the nomination of each of these individuals from the Executive Office on Aging.
