Your Committee on Education, to which was referred S.B.
No. 1994 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT
MANOA,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to make an appropriation for
capital improvement projects for the Campus Center building at the
University of Hawai'i at Manoa.

Testimony in support of this measure was submitted by the
University of Hawai'i at Manoa, the Associated Students of the
University of Hawaii at Mānoa, and the University of Hawaii at
Manoa Campus Center Board.

Your Committee finds that as campus enrollment has increased
steadily over the years, the University of Hawaii at Manoa Campus
Center is in need of renovations and expansion. The plans for the
Campus Center expansion have received overwhelming support and
approval from the students and the University of Hawaii at Manoa.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Education that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
No. 1994 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be
referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
