Your Committee on Judiciary and Labor, to which was referred  
S.B. No. 2399 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO STATUTORY REVISION: AMENDING

The purpose of this measure is to amend various provisions of  
the Hawaii Revised Statutes and the Session Laws of Hawaii  
pursuant to the statute revision program of the Legislative

All amendments are of a purely technical nature and correct  
errors, update references, clarify language, and delete obsolete  
or unnecessary language. As is the case each year, the bill was  
reviewed by the Office of the Attorney General prior to  
introduction.

Committee on Judiciary and Labor that is attached to this report,  
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
