Madam:

Your Committee on Judiciary and Labor, to which was referred
S.B. No. 2961 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST
THE STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to the
Department of the Attorney General to satisfy claims against the
State or its officers or employees for overpayment of taxes,
refunds, reimbursements, payments of judgments or settlements, or
for other liabilities.

Testimony in support of this measure was submitted by the
Department of the Attorney General.

Your Committee finds that the appropriation of these sums is
necessary to satisfy various claims against the State.

Your Committee has amended this measure pursuant to the
testimony of the Department of the Attorney General to add
appropriations for five additional claims that have been settled
or have had a judgment rendered against the State since the
introduction of this measure.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Judiciary and Labor that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
No. 2961, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
