Your Committees on Human Services and Public Housing and Intergovernmental and Military Affairs, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 44 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT FOR WOMEN IN WASHINGTON, D.C., TO RECOGNIZE AND HONOR THE CONTRIBUTIONS TO LEADERSHIP BY AMERICA'S WOMEN,"

The purpose of this measure is to request the United States Congress to give statutorily-required authorization for the establishment of a national monument to honor the contributions to leadership by America's women in Washington, D.C.
