<u>HB 3172</u>	RELATING TO ELECTRONIC FILINGS IN THE BUREAU OF CONVEYANCES AND THE OFFICE OF THE ASSISTANT REGISTRAR. Authorizes the Registrar and Assistant Registrar of the Bureau of Conveyance to accept electronic signatures and electronically filed documents in lieu of an original document with original signatures. <u>HB 2302, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR266-08)</u>	RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY. Permits the registrar of the bureau of conveyances to accept electronic documents with electronic signatures for recording. Requires the judiciary to study what effect electronic recording may have on the adjudication of land court applications, determine permissible uses for electronic recording, and report its findings to the legislature prior to 2009 regular session. <u>HB 2438, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR263-08)</u>	RELATING TO CIGARETTES. Establishes a process to ensure that only fire-safe cigarettes are sold in Hawaii. (HB2438 HD1)	HLT, CPC/JUD, FIN
<u>HB 3085, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR175-08)</u>	RELATING TO BUSINESS REGISTRATION. Reorganizes and resolves inconsistencies, gaps, and ambiguities in the law relating to registration and protection of trademarks, tradenames, and service marks. (HB3085 HD1)	EDB, CPC/JUD, FIN



DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

- Measure number; and
- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

PAPER: 5 copies (including an original) to CPC Vice Chair, Room 315, in the State Capitol; or


