<u>HB 2527, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR794-08)</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SMART GROWTH. Requires the Department of Land and Natural Resources to establish a system of greenways and trails. Requires the Office of Planning to coordinate smart growth planning. Effective 07/01/2020. (HB2527 HD1)	CPH, WAM
