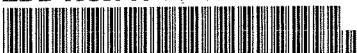
RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.


